We ride the most exciting gravel roads and mountain passes spanning Lesotho and the Eastern Cape, all set in a stunning, ever changing landscape. With the perfect mix of action & adventure blended with the ideal amount of relaxing & taking it easy - this trip is set to amaze.

ITINERARY & SIGHTSEEING

Day 1: Arrival in Cape Town

Arrive in Cape Town with iconic Table Mountain as your stunning backdrop. transfer you to historic Stellenbosch, in the heart of the Boland wine region where you receive your motorcycles. Enjoy a relaxing stay in this university town and prepare for the tour departure.

Day 2: Stellenbosch to Graaff Reinet

An early departure will see us on our way through the beautiful Karoo region to our rest stop in historic Graaff Reinet. We detour on gravel back roads, time permitting

Day 3 : Graaff Reinet to Burgersdorp

We ride through the scenic Kamdeboo National Park and detour on forgotten gravel roads to Nieu Bethesda.

Day 4: Burgersdorp to Malealea

We enter Lesotho at the Tele Bridge border post. Initially we follow the asphalt road north, but then turn off onto glorious gravel roads that will remain our constant companion throughout. We head into the mountains to Malealea, our overnight

Day 5: Malealea to Semonkong

Today is gravel travel delight, riding several narrow and steep passes. We visit the awesome Maletsunyana waterfall in the afternoon before riding to Semonkong, our rest stop for the night.

Day 6 : Semonkong to Katse Dam

Expect awesome vistas of the sweeping Lesotho countryside, valleys, rivers and glorious mountains which we will ascend and descend at regular intervals. We ride through the town of Roma and summit the "Godhelp-me Pass". From Thaba Tseka we follow the 60 km gravel road to Katse Dam for a well-deserved rest.

Day 7: Katse Dam to Himeville

The ride to Sani Top is an adventure rider's delight. Beautiful vistas with numerous mountain passes. We crest the Black Mountain Pass at 3250m before descending to Sani Top, home of the highest pub in Africa. We descend the Sani Pass for a comfortable stay in Himeville. Another, great, African adventure biking day.

Day 8: Himeville to Rhodes

Today, we ride the highest gravel mountain pass in South Africa Naudesnek Pass. It is a brilliant gravel ride with awesome vistas

Day 9: Rhodes to Lady Grey

Our route takes us over Lundean's Neck Pass back to the Lesotho border from where we follow the Tele river to its confluence with the Sengu river. Outside Lady Grey we conclude the day by summiting the beautiful Jouberts Pass.
