

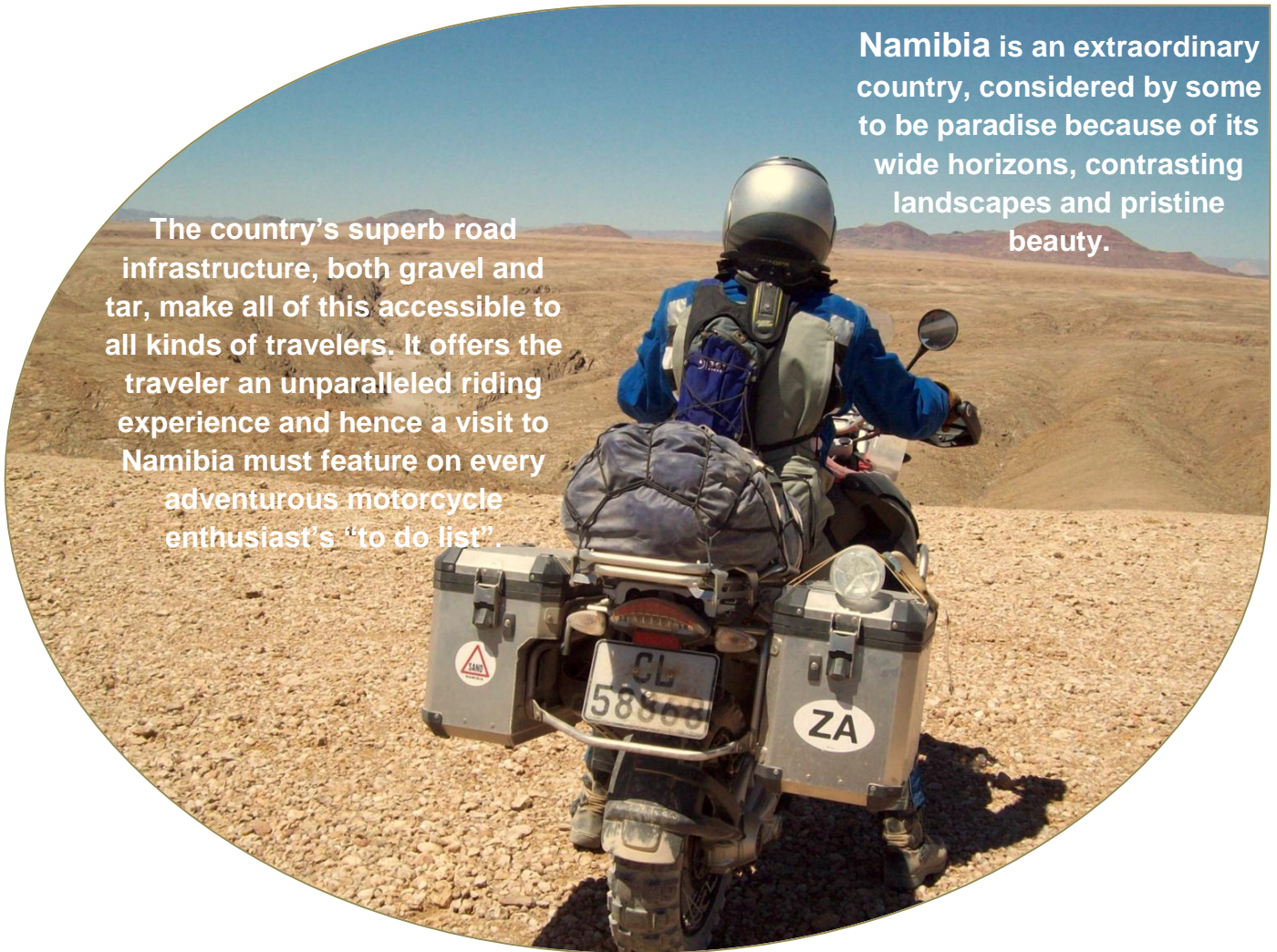


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Namibia Desert Xplorer Tour

ITINERARY & SIGHTSEEING

Day 1 : Arrival in Cape Town

Arrive in Cape Town with iconic Table Mountain as the backdrop. Transfer to historic Stellenbosch, in the heart of the Boland wine region and receive your motorcycles. We enjoy a relaxing stay in this university town and prepare for the tour departure.

Day 2 : Cape Town to Lamberts Bay

We ride north along the South African West Coast, testing our gravel riding skills on tamer roads along the way to arrive in Lamberts Bay for an authentic West Coast experience.

- ☉ Dinner at Muisbosskerm

Day 3 : Lamberts Bay to Ausenkehr

The journey north continues through the harsh but beautiful Namaqualand region and cross the Orange River into Namibia. We head for our relaxing overnight stop next to the great river.

Day 4 : Ausenkehr to Aus

Today we ready ourselves for a brilliant gravel ride along the Orange River and through the awesome Namibian Richtersveldt to arrive in Aus Gravel Ride along Orange River

- ☉ Gravel ride along Orange River

Day 5 : Aus -Luderitz-Aus

We ride to Luderitz, the coastal town pressed against the desert dunes. We explore Kolmanskop, the ghost mining town of yester year. On our way back to Aus we pay a visit to Garub and with a bit of luck we may spot the feral desert horses

- ☉ Kolmanskop Ghost town
- ☉ Feral horses at Garub

Day 6 : Aus to Sesriem

The journey continues north through the beautiful and harsh desert landscapes to Sesriem that borders the red Namib dunes and Namib Naukluft Park.

- ☉ Glorious gravel ride to Sesriem
- ☉ Overnight stay as Sossusvlei Lodge

Day 7 : Sesriem to Solitaire

We visit the Namib Naukluft Park and experience the desert at Sossusvlei and Dooievlei. Time permitting; we walk through the Sesriem Canyon. We ride to Solitaire.

- ☉ Visit to Sossusvlei and Dooievlei – a unique desert experience

Day 8 : Solitaire to Swakopmund

The journey continues north through beautiful landscapes. We stop at the Kuiseb Canyon and explore the "Henno Martin" shelter on foot. We arrive in Swakopmund - "Little Germany by the Sea" with its colonial feel to experience the culture for two days.

Day 9 : Rest Day - Swakopmund

A leisure day in Swakopmund to explore the town, Optional out-ride to the "Moon landscape", Welwitschia Route or riding quad bikes in the surrounding dunes

Day 10 : Swakopmund to Windhoek

We head for Windhoek, but detour first with a visit to the iconic Spitzkoppe mountains. Tonight we dine at the famous "Joe's Beerhouse".

- ☉ Spitzkoppe Mountains
- ☉ Dinner at Joes Beerhouse

Day 11 : Windhoek to Seeheim

From Windhoek we head south and detour around the iconic Brukaros Crater to ride glorious gravel roads to Seeheim, a true oasis in harsh landscape.

Day 12 : Seeheim to Ais Ais

The tour would not be complete without a visit to the majestic Fish River Canyon, second in size only to the Grand Canyon. We ride to Ai Ais for a relaxing stay at the healing hot water springs

- ☉ Fish River Canyon
- ☉ Ais Ais Hot Springs

Day 13 : Seeheim to Strandfontein

We head for the border and back in South Africa where we stop for the night at the seaside town of Strandfontein.

Day 14 : Strandfontein to Cape Town

We ride hard to arrive early afternoon in Cape Town, allowing time to explore the great city at leisure
